Regulatory status of Polystyrene virgin.

EU-Directive 2011/65/EU- Restriction of Hazardous Substances, RoHS

Please be advised that we have reviewed the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU repealing the Directive 2002/95/EC. We confirm that polystyrene virgin is in compliance and the supplier does not deliberately add Lead, Mercury, Cadmium, Chromium-VI, Polybrominated Biphenyls and Polybrominated Diphenylethers to these polymers, nor are these substances present to the best of our knowledge in any of the raw materials used to manufacture the polymers.

Please note that the supplier has carried out heavy metal testing on several representative grades and can confirm that the above mentioned products will not contain these substances above the threshold limits of 0.01% by weight for Cadmium and 0.1% by weight for Lead, Mercury, Chromium-VI, Polybrominated Biphenyls and Polybrominated Diphenylethers.
